



Ranger Camp Policy

Purpose

This document sets policy for use of Ranger Camp at **320 Raymond Street, Gardner, MA** by the Royal Rangers of Southern New England Ministry Network (SNEMN). It defines who can use the facilities, what the fees are, what is included in the fees and some guidelines to ensure all of us have a pleasant camping experience. Outposts that plan to use Ranger Camp must contact the District Director or Camp Property Coordinator to check availability. Upon receipt of payment, the Outpost Coordinator will receive a passcode to access the Camp.

Who can use Ranger Camp?

Ranger Camp is open to all "Chartered" (registered) Outposts in SNEMN.

Fees

- A. Any outpost wishing to use a site or camp will be charged a \$75.00 fee per portable toilet used. This fee covers the cost of portable toilet cleaning.
- B. Barn use must be approved. An additional \$25.00 fee will be collected for use of the Barn.
- C. A \$50 fee will be collected for trash left behind. Please remember, *Royal Rangers Leave it Better than they found it.*
- D. All fees are to be made out to Southern New England Ministry Network, Royal Rangers (Memo). Mail checks to **Royal Rangers 18 Cart Road, New Haven, CT 06512**

What's included?

- A. \$75.00 fee is used to cover cost of cleaning the portable toilet after event. Portable Toilets are to be cleaned immediately after events and left ready to use for next event.
- B. The waterfront will be available for outposts to use, however, outposts assume all risks in doing so and must provide adequate lifeguards.
- C. The Shooting Range may be used under proper supervision for archery or BB gun events only. Only District sanctioned shooting events under the supervision of a Range Safety Officer will be allowed.
- D. The barn is locked and is off limits unless arrangements are made in advance. Additional costs for use of the barn may apply.

When can the camp be used?

- A. From Camp Opening Day in May to Camp Closing in October.
- B. Outposts are encouraged to use the property at any time during the year except when used for other District events. District events are posted on the Royal Ranger Calendar and will be posted on the SNEMN RR website. Check ahead because we do rent the camp to other groups from time to time.
- C. We understand that Camp offers a great opportunity for Winter Camping, and request can be made for off season camping. Approvals will be made on case to case basis. No water will be available as the camp is winterized for the season.
